Dear Parents and carers

Some dates for your diary and information about the events that will be happening over the next two weeks.

**Camping Day:**

On Friday 14<sup>th</sup> July all children in EYFS, Year 1 and Year 2 are invited to take part in our annual camping day on our field. If your child has a tent (a small pop up tent is fine), they will be able to bring it to school and we would appreciate it if parents could assemble their own child's tent on the back field before the start of the school day. Registration will take place in class as usual at 8.55am. We appreciate that not everyone has a tent as children are encouraged to share so everyone has a 'camping experience'. In fact, the children love spending time together in one tent, so please don't rush out and buy one.

Children will need to bring a named bowl and spoon as well as water bottles, sun cream and hats. Please make sure you apply sun cream before school. They do not need to wear school uniform but should wear comfortable clothes as they will be playing games. Children may also bring in a board game or comic which they may share with their friends in their tent. (No electronic games please or any games which are of value.)

The children will be able to have breakfast at school and we will supply Rice Krispies and Shreddies. If your child is allergic to cereals or milk, please let their class teacher know before the day. They can also bring in their own choice of cereal in a small plastic bag. We would also welcome any contributions of cakes to share in the afternoon.

**Beach Day:**

On Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> July it will be beach afternoon for the whole school. The children will take part in a carousel of three activities, one of which will be water play where children get changed into swim wear and can squirt each other with water. They will need to bring a named swimming costume to change into and a named towel in a plastic bag. If children wish to play with water pistols they must be named and be a sensible size – water pistols that are too big, too powerful or need to run off a hose pipe will not be allowed. Do not worry if your child does not have a water pistol, an old water bottle or washing up liquid bottle works just as well! There will be an area for children to paddle for those who don't like being squirted.

Children can come to school in beach clothes for the day; however children in Rowan class need to come in their school uniform as they have their leavers assembly in the morning. Children in Rowan can bring in a set of beach clothes to change into after their leavers assembly.

If you have a paddling pool you could lend to us please bring it in on the morning of 20<sup>th</sup> July.

Hopefully these two days will be a sunny day so all children will need hats and sun cream, however the events do rely on good weather so please do check for notices in your child's bag and on the doors/ whiteboards nearer the day.

Finally, it will be toy day on Friday 21<sup>st</sup> July when all children can bring in a toy or game of their choice to share with their friends. Please bring toys in a named bag and remind children that they are responsible for their own toy. We would ask that children do not bring in electronic toys/games or ones that are precious.
