**As a school we will:**

1. Provide a high standard of education
2. Provide the best possible learning environment that is safe, nurturing and caring
3. Ensure your child's physical, social and emotional wellbeing at all times and foster feelings of confidence, self-worth and belonging
4. Be committed to, and have high expectations of your child's behaviour and learning
5. Offer a balanced and carefully planned curriculum which meets the needs of your individual child

10. Set homework tasks that consolidate or extend learning.

**We expect pupils to:**

3. Wear school uniform and take pride in their appearance
4. Be organised and bring the correct equipment to school
5. Listen carefully and follow instructions the first time
6. Always try their best
7. Let an adult know if they have any worries.

**We expect you as parents and carers to:**

1. Make sure your child is ready to learn by:  
*providing a healthy breakfast; prioritising and encouraging healthy amounts of sleep; providing a water bottle; helping with organisation of resources eg homework, PE kit; welly boots*
2. Make sure your child arrives promptly to school at 8.45am
3. Ensure that your child wears the appropriate school uniform and kit for P.E.
4. Make sure that your child maintains a high level of attendance (at least 96%) and take family holidays during published holiday times
5. Support the school's positive behaviour and anti-bullying policies and work with the school to ensure that your child behaves well and upholds the Golden Values: Be ready to learn, Be respectful, Be safe
6. Treat all members of staff with the same respect as you would expect from them, including on social media
7. Encourage and support your child in completing homework tasks and wherever possible promote opportunities for home learning
8. Attend parents evenings and discussions about your child's progress at school
9. Inform the school of any circumstances that may affect your child's ability to learn effectively.
